

LRCC Clubhouse Rules

- Clubhouse hours are listed on your LRCC calendar. These hours are subject to change depending on weather. Please call LRCC at 423-3411 for further information.
- Scrip cards may be picked up at the bar. Your signature is required for pick-up. Scrip may be used in the restaurant and bar for purchases and gratuity. The scrip card is a debit-type card that will work like a gift card. LRCC is not responsible for lost or stolen cards.
- Fish Fry is served on Friday Nights from 5:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. beginning the first Friday in May and ending the last Friday in September. Reservations are required. Table size is limited to 12 maximum. No-shows on Friday nights continue to be a problem at LRCC. Please call and cancel as soon as your plans change as this is inconsiderate to other members who were turned away. In addition, this causes loss of revenue to LRCC that may affect dues.
- Sunday Breakfast is served from 7:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. beginning the first Sunday after Mother's Day and ending the last Sunday in September. For tables of 8 or more, reservations are required. Table size may be limited. Check your calendar for further information. There is no regular breakfast served on the Sunday after Labor Day due to the Men's Shotgun.
- There is no smoking in the dining room or lounge.
- Members are allowed to bring guests to LRCC. Guests must be with a club member in order to golf or utilize the clubhouse. Members are responsible for their guests paying greens fees, slow play, and conduct at LRCC. Individual guests may play golf up to six times per year accompanied by a member.
- Tuesday is designated as Ladies' Day. Men and children shall not use the clubhouse or be on the grounds, except for the men's locker room, prior to 1:00 p.m. EXCEPTION: During April and October, men are allowed to play and use the locker room beginning at 12:00 p.m.
- Thursday is designated as Men's Day. Women and children shall not use the clubhouse after 10:00 a.m. except that women may use the women's locker facilities.
- Mother's Day Dinner will be served from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Reservations are required.
- Club events will be held throughout the summer. Check the calendar for dates. Further events will be announced in the newsletter or on the bulletin board.
- Friendliness, cooperation, common sense and the golden rule shall be expected of every member, family and guest. Thoughtfulness helps your club to run smoothly and successfully.

Children's Rules

- Children can play under their parent's membership until their 19th birthday. Upon reaching age 19, they may apply for club membership or use the club as a guest of a member.
- No child under the age of eight years shall be allowed on the golf course at any time.
- Children under the age of eight years are authorized to practice golf, when accompanied by a parent, on the driving range east of Number 9 fairway.
- Members' children have no guest privileges.
- Children are not allowed to make reservations or use the dining room unless accompanied by a parent or adult member.
- Children are not allowed to sit at the bar. They may sit in the lounge or pit area.
- Children between the ages of 8-15 years are entitled to play Monday through Friday, subject to Tuesday and Thursday special rules. (See LRCC golf course rules) On Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, children between the ages of 8-15 years may play after 3:00 p.m. provided they are accompanied by an adult member.
- Children between 16-18 years are entitled to play Monday through Sunday, subject to Tuesday and Thursday special rules.
- Children under the age of 16 years are not allowed to operate a golf cart on LRCC property.
- Parents are required to teach their children proper golf etiquette, the rules of golf and common sense rules that allow the game to function in an orderly fashion.
- Children playing on their parent's membership can not play in any club tournament.
- Parents are responsible for their children's actions at LRCC.
